


WHO WE ARE

The Foundation is a 501c3 organization that supports SC&RA members and the crane, rigging and specialized transportation industry through industry specific research and education, scholarships and grants.










IMPACTING FUTURES AND **CHANGING LIVES**

The Foundation has the greatest impact and is most often recognized for its scholarship and grant program. Since 1986, more than \$480,000 has been awarded to 130 students and employees. In 2014 the Foundation opened the Grant program to the public and increased the number of awards and amount awarded to \$30,000 annually. Grant recipients often report that the money awarded is a "game changer" for them and their families. Scholarship awards total \$27,000 annually. Award recipients are pursuing a job in the industry or seek to improve their skills to advance their career path in the industry.
